Opportunities to Learn about our City

LearningBOSTON is an interactive adventure for children in mixed age groups. This summer we will create one or more large scale collaborative works of art, to which all students will contribute. Each child, in a partnership or group, will consider ways to represent the city of Boston, its history, and its culture. Our ultimate goal is to make an artistic contribution to the city, which communicates the shared message of our group.

About the LearningBOSTON Day

Children arrive at the school at 8:30 AM for a group meeting in the Earth Lab to discuss the upcoming day. Each day, there is a planned excursion by foot or by T as children learn about art in our city. Together we observe, draw, photograph, and write about various art forms that include sculpture, gardens, and community art in the neighborhoods and in Boston's museums. We gather together to share our learnings, our ideas, and our documentation. Throughout the process we will get to know art around the city and design one or more collaborative works of our own. Children bring snack and lunch. Pick-up is at 5 PM.
